

Windows 7 Support is Ending Soon

Microsoft recently announced that support for Windows 7 will stop in January of 2020 and we want to let you know what this means and how it will affect your business.

How will this affect my business?

Once Microsoft stops supporting Windows 7 they will no longer monitor bug reports. There will be no new security fixes or official support and the Operating System and all programs running on it will begin to slowly degrade and more quickly become insecure.

This means that our HST techs will not be able to update your operating systems, which will leave your system vulnerable to hackers and breaches.
